Visits are connected to school work and will take place in school time. There may be occasions where trips run slightly out of school time (8am-6pm) and we will inform you of this in advance.

Visits will always be supervised and will follow the Girls' Day School Trust guidelines for school visits and may involve the use of a hired coach. We will let you know in advance that such a visit is taking place.

School Trips Code of Conduct 2020

We hope that all school visits provide a valuable and enjoyable experience for all participants. We would ask for your support as parents in helping the staff who arrange and supervise these visiting to ensure that your child is aware that they must take full responsibility for their behaviour at all times. We expect all pupils to comply fully with the Code of Conduct as stated below. If any pupil does not comply with the Code of Conduct the supervising member of staff reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary measures.

Pupils must:

1. Behave in a courteous and respectable manner;
2. follow carefully, and without question, all instructions given by members of staff and the supervisors;
3. only take part in activities that are directed and supervised by staff;
4. at all times move around in groups as allocated by the trip leader and never leave anyone alone;
5. remain in their seats on the coach and seat belts must be used on all journeys;
6. look after their personal property, such as cameras, clothing etc;
7. report any accidents or illness immediately to a member of staff;
8. report any damage, however caused;
9. not exchange personal details with people who are not part of the group;
10. not take photographs of people without permission;
11. take their litter with them at all times, especially from the coach and picnic sites
